

The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in August 2021. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried.

Naval District Washington

General Court-Martial

Navy Region Mid-Atlantic

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, ETNC Adam N. Montgomery, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to aggravated assault and assault consummated by a battery upon a child under 16 years. On 28 August 2021, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 38 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all confinement greater than 24 months will be suspended. The suspended punishment may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, FN Darryl Spearman, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of attempted indecent recording, one specification of wrongful use of a controlled substance, and one specification of obstructing justice. On 4 August 2021, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 8 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, an E-5 was tried for wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 6 August 2021, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, MA3 Anthony D. Stith, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to unauthorized absence for more than 3 days but not more than 30 days and missing movement by design. On 31 August 2021, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to a confinement for 3 days and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Navy Region Southeast

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, an E-3 was tried for sexual assault. On 5 August 2021, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a General Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, ETN3 Alexander S. Nesbit, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to attempted sexual abuse of a child and attempted receipt of child pornography. On 20 August 2021, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 6 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Navy Region Northwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, PFC Logan O. Evans, USMC, was tried for two specifications of abusive sexual contact, one specification of assault consummated by a battery, one specification of simple assault, and one specification of drunk and disorderly conduct. On 12 August 2021, the panel of members returned a verdict of guilty to two specifications of abusive sexual contact, one specification of assault consummated by a battery, one specification of simple assault, and one specification of drunk and disorderly conduct and sentenced him to confinement for 150 days.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, an E-4 was tried for violation of a lawful general order by hazing. On 19 August 2021, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, an E-3 was tried for violation of a lawful general order by hazing. On 19 August 2021, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, BM1 Marcel D. Hatcher, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to four specifications of selling military property of a value of more than \$1,000. On 27 August 2021, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to a fine of \$4,000, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 9 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Navy Region Southwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, DCFN James C. Hart, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to larceny of property of a value of \$1,000 or less; discharging a firearm through negligence; violation of a lawful general order by actively advocating supremacist and extreme doctrine, ideology, and causes; violation of a lawful order by possessing a firearm in his barracks onboard Naval Base San Diego; violation of a lawful order by possessing ammunition in his barracks onboard Naval Base San Diego; and willfully engaging in the business of dealing in firearms without a license as a firearms dealer. On 26 August 2021, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 23 months, and a Dishonorable Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, AC1 Suzette A. Prado, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to 13 specifications of larceny, 1 specification of wrongful appropriation, and 1 specification of violation of a lawful general order by wrongfully visiting a casino. On 18 August 2021, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced her to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 11 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
