

The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in February 2021. The cases below are organized according to the Navy Region in which they were tried.

Naval District Washington

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Washington, D.C., CS1 Jose Tejada, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to rape of a child, two specifications of sexual assault of a child, and one specification of producing child pornography. On 24 February 2021, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to confinement for 36 years and a Dishonorable Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Washington, D.C., IS2 Eros A. Marte, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to wrongful possession of a controlled substance and five specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 8 February 2021, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 30 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Navy Region Mid-Atlantic

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, an E-2, USN, was tried for two specifications of sexual assault. On 1 February 2021, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, an E-6, USN, was tried for rape of a child, two specifications of sexual assault of a child, and assault consummated by a battery of a child. On 11 February 2021, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Groton, Connecticut, STSSN Chance M. Ramirez, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to abusive sexual contact and two specifications of indecent exposure. On 18 February 2021, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 8 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge. The pretrial agreement had no effect on his sentence.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, YNS2 Marlon B. Bentley, USN, pled guilty to five specifications of larceny of military property. On 18 February 2021, the panel of members sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-4, forfeiture of \$943 per month for 4 months, and restriction for 60 days.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, ASCM Jeffrey W. Powell, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to assault consummated by a battery. On 26 February 2021, the military judge sentenced him to a reprimand and forfeiture of \$500 per month for 2 months. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all forfeitures are to be disapproved. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Navy Region Southeast

General Court-Martial

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Pensacola, Florida, an E-6, USMC, was tried for wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 5 February 2021, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, LSSN Imani C. Weston, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to violating a lawful general order by dining at an off-installation dine-in restaurant and two specifications of damaging military property. On 22 February 2021, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced her to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and forfeiture of \$800 per month for 12 months. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Navy Region Northwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, MA3 Javante T. Oniel, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to obstruction of justice and three specifications of bank fraud. On 3 February 2021, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, a fine of \$7,500, confinement for 364 days, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

- **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, MMA3 Edward M. Montgomery, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to two specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 18 February 2021, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-3 and confinement for 90 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Navy Region Southwest

General Court-Martial

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, SO1 Adel A. Enayat, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to assault consummated by a battery. On 2 February 2021, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 90 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Navy Region Japan

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, MMA1 Terrell T. Hunter, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to viewing child pornography and three specifications of possession of child pornography. On 16 February 2021, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 67 months, and a Dishonorable Discharge. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all confinement greater than 36 months is to be suspended. The suspended punishment may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Naples, Italy, IT1 Ademola Wood, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to false official statement and four specifications of larceny of military property. On 24 February 2021, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to forfeit \$1,000 per month for 6 months and a fine of \$9,000.
