

The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in February 2022. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried.

Naval District Washington

General Court-Martial

Navy Region Mid-Atlantic

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Groton, Connecticut, an E-1, USN, was tried for four specifications of sexual assault. On 22 February 2022, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, ABHAA Marquelle S. Wormley, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to failure to go to his appointed place of duty for less than three days and two specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 4 February 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1 and confinement for 17 days. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, CSSSN Byron M. Humbers, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to extortion. On 28 February 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 9 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Navy Region Southeast

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Pensacola, Florida, UTCN Charles E. Goss, USN, pled guilty to abusive sexual contact. On 4 February 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 90 days, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, AOAN Will C. Pruitt, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to attempted sexual abuse of a child involving indecent communications. On 24 February 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 9 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Pensacola, Florida, HM1 Eric J. Alamosario, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to seven specifications of violation of a lawful general regulation for fraternization and two specifications of abuse of a training leadership position. On 17 February 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 60 days, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Navy Region Northwest

General Court-Martial

- At a re-sentencing hearing in Bremerton, Washington for a previously held General Court-Martial in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, MMN1 Matthew D. Norwood, USN, was sentenced for sexual abuse of a child involving sexual contact. On 24 February 2022, the panel of members sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 18 months, and a Dishonorable Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, CS3 Diajion T. Foxworth, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to drunk and disorderly conduct. On 18 February 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 31 days. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, AE1 Aaren D. Painter, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to indecent recording. On 28 February 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-3, confinement for 8 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Navy Region Hawaii

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, CTI3 Damien K. Butts, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to possession of child pornography. On 23 February 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 10 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, O SSA Avery S. Childers, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to indecent conduct and assault consummated by a battery. On 11 February 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1 and confinement for 4 months. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
