

The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial convened within the United States Navy in January 2020. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried.

Naval District Washington

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Washington, D.C., HM3 Ignacio Delgado, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to sexual abuse of a child. On 6 January 2020, the military judge sentenced him to be discharged with a Dishonorable Discharge, to forfeit all pay and allowances, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 7 years. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement all confinement greater than 4 years is to be suspended. The suspended punishment may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement.

Navy Region Mid-Atlantic

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, an E-5 was tried for aggravated arson. On 23 January 2020, a panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, ABFAA Blanzaja R. Colon, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to unauthorized absence terminated by apprehension, three specifications of unauthorized absence, four specifications of missing movement through neglect, and one specification of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 3 January 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to confinement for 63 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, MASN Jordan L. Vig, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to wrongful possession of drug paraphernalia and two specifications of wrongful distribution of a controlled substance. On 30 January 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to be discharged with a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 170 days.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, CTR3 Robert H. Crisell III, USN, was tried for indecent recording. On 15 January 2020, the panel of members returned a verdict of guilty of indecent viewing and sentenced him to forfeit \$1,155 per month for 6 months, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 6 months.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, an E-5 was tried for simple assault with an unloaded firearm. On 21 January 2020, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, SA Aleshia R. Williams, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to conspiracy to commit obstruction of justice, two specifications of false official statement, and one specification of failure to go to appointed place or duty. On 23 January 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced her to a reprimand, to forfeit \$865 per month for 4 months, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 120 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, BMC Kathy M. Tonnah, USN, was tried for larceny. On 27 January 2020, the military judge returned a verdict of guilty of larceny and sentenced her to a reprimand and to forfeit \$1,000 per month for 1 month.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, MM3 Bradley A. Marr, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to assault consummated by a battery. On 30 January 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to no further punishment. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, AMC Andrea Ariano, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to two specifications of larceny. On 31 January 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced her to a reprimand and a fine of \$1,750.

Navy Region Northwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, ABEAN Malyah L.R. Coleman, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to false official statement and indecent language. On 21 January 2020, the military judge sentenced her to be discharged with a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 6 months. The pretrial agreement had no effect on her sentence.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, EMN3 Stephen G. Ingui, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to conspiracy to wrongfully use and distribute a controlled substance and three specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 7 January 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 7 months. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, ABEAN Devin M. Durrett, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to breach of restriction, wrongful use of a controlled substance, and two specifications of missing movement through design. On 13 January 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to be discharged with a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 54 days.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, TM3 Logan M. Fox, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to two specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 21 January 2020, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 60 days. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement all confinement greater than 45 days is to be suspended. The suspended punishment may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, MMN2 Yoandry A. Sosa Amigo, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to three specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 28 January 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 33 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, MMA2 Trevor D. Tipton, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to two specifications of assault consummated by a battery. On 30 January 2020, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-2 and confinement for 120 days. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement all confinement greater than 60 days is to be suspended and any adjudged reduction below the paygrade of E-4 is to be disapproved. The suspended punishment may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, MMN2 Nicholas W. Freidline, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to conspiracy to wrongful use and two specifications of distribution of a controlled substance. On 31 January 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement the military judge sentenced him to be discharged with a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 5 months.

Navy Region Southwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, an E-5 was tried for abusive sexual contact and sexual assault. On 16 January 2020, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, GSMFN Kendall L. Terry, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to violation of a general regulation, negligent discharge of a firearm, and wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 27 January 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 90 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, MA2 Jose C. Cruz, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to attempted larceny, unauthorized absence, willful disobedience of a noncommissioned petty officer, and larceny. On 8 January 2020, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-3, to forfeit \$1,500 per month for 2 months, and restriction for 2 months. The pretrial agreement had no effect on the sentence. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, AN Deaven C. Noble, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to distribution of a controlled substance. On 21 January 2020, the military judge sentenced him to be discharged with a Bad Conduct Discharge and confinement for 6 months. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, the punitive discharge and confinement greater than 90 days are to be disapproved. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California STGSN Vernon R. Moore III, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to assault consummated by a battery, aggravated assault (strangulation), and aggravated assault (dangerous weapon other than

a loaded firearm). On 24 January 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to be discharged with a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 12 months.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, MA3 Chase A. Burns, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to attempted indecent communications with a child and attempted indecent exposure to child. On 29 January 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 60 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
