

The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in July 2022. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried.

Naval District Washington

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Washington D.C., an E-2, USN, was tried for one specification of sexual assault and two specifications of abusive sexual contact. On 21 July 2022, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty to all charges.

Special Court-Martial

Navy Region Mid-Atlantic

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, ENS Winton D. Lunceford, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to absence without leave more than 30 days terminated by apprehension and to missing movement by design. On 19 July 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 42 days confinement and a Dismissal.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, SN Kyle Roland, Jr., USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of absence without leave not more than 3 days, two specifications of absence without leave more than 3 but not more than 30 days, and two specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 8 July 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 46 days of confinement and reduction in paygrade to E-1. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, an E-6, USN, was tried for wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 19 July 2022, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, CDR Dennis A. Szpara, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of obstruction of justice and two specifications of conduct unbecoming an officer. On 29 July 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to no punishment. The plea agreement contained a requirement to submit a retirement request.

Navy Region Southeast

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in New Orleans, Louisiana, AWF1 Tarick L. Brittingham, USN, was tried for absence without leave for going from his appointed place of duty and disrespect toward a superior commissioned officer. On 8 July 2022, the military judge returned a verdict of guilty to disrespect toward a superior commissioned officer. The military judge sentenced him to receive a reprimand.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, an E-4, USN, was tried for dereliction in the performance of duties. On 13 July 2022, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.

Navy Region Northwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, an O-4, USN, was tried for two specifications of rape of a child and one specification of sexual abuse of a child. On 1 July 2022, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a General Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, an E-5, USN, was tried for two specifications of rape of a child and one specification of sexual abuse of a child. On 15 July 2022, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, HM1 Anthony M. Clark, USN, was tried for one specification of possession of a controlled substance, one specification of introduction of a controlled substance, eight specifications of wrongful use of a

controlled substance, and three specifications of larceny of property of a value of \$1,000 or less. On 19 July 2022, the panel of members returned a verdict of guilty to eight specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance and three specifications of larceny of property of a value of \$1,000 or less. The panel of members sentenced him to forfeitures of \$1,200 per month for 12 months, reduction in paygrade to E-1, and to receive a reprimand.

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, CSSN Sergio L. Martinez, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to wrongful distribution of an intimate visual image. On 28 July 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 7 days of confinement and reduction in paygrade to E-1. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, an E-5, USN, was tried for two specifications of indecent recording. On 19 July 2022, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.
