

The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in June 2022. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried.

Naval District Washington

General Court-Martial

Navy Region Mid-Atlantic

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, MM1 Kimanie J. Harriott, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of desertion terminated by apprehension, one specification of willful dereliction in performance of duties, and six specifications of false official statements. On 15 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to confinement for 12 months, reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, AN Clyde F. Hyatt, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to absence without leave for more than 30 days and wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 2 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to confinement for 30 days and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, MM2 Derak J. Bell, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to child endangerment and disorderly conduct. On 8 June 2022, the military judge sentenced him to no punishment. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, an E-3, USN, was tried for two specifications of larceny and two specifications of burglary. On 16 June 2022, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, ATAN Robert R. Noseworthy, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to absence without leave for more than 30 days terminated by apprehension and two specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 21 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge

sentenced him to confinement for 105 days. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Great Lakes, Illinois, AD1 DeLeorean D. Lambert, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of violation of a general order and one specification of prohibited activities with a military recruit by a person in position of special trust. On 21 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1 and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Navy Region Southeast

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, IC1 David L. Lalumia, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of assault consummated by a battery upon an intimate partner. On 8 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to forfeit \$1,623 pay per month for 6 months, reduction in paygrade to E-3, and confinement for 180 days. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a General Court-Martial in Pensacola, Florida, LSSN Neal A. Sutton, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of abusive sexual contact and one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 9 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 14 days, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a General Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, MMN3 Dylan J. Dioguardi, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to attempted sexual abuse of a child. On 27 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to forfeit all pay and allowances, reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 18 months, and a Dishonorable Discharge.
- At a General Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, OS3 Derek J. Henry, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of attempted sexual abuse of a child. On 28 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 9 months and 15 days, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Pensacola, Florida, ATAA Edward S. Delatorre, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of damaging military property of a value of more than \$1,000, one specification of damaging military property of a value \$1,000 or less, and one specification of drunk and disorderly conduct. On 3 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to confinement for

30 days. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, FCA3 Enrique Vivarperez, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to assault consummated by a battery. On 7 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 120 days, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, ABF2 Eddie C. Walker, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to a violation of a general order. On 30 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Navy Region Northwest

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, RS2 Justin E. Caphart, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of violation of a general order. On 21 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1 and confinement for 60 days. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Navy Region Southwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, HMC Marvin B. Guzman, USN, was tried for violation of a general order, prohibited activities with a military recruit by a person in a position of special trust, and obstruction of justice. On 24 June 2022, the panel of members found him guilty of violation of a general order, prohibited activities with a military recruit by a person in a position of special trust, and obstruction of justice. The military judge sentenced him to no punishment.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, OS3 Keivion E. Bonner, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to absence without leave for 3 days or less, absence without leave for more than 30 days terminated by apprehension, disrespect towards a superior noncommissioned petty officer, and three specifications of wrongful use of a

controlled substance. On 24 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1.

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, FN Samuel A. Cano, USN, was tried for wrongfully broadcasting an intimate visual image of another. On 30 June 2022, the panel of members found him guilty of wrongfully broadcasting an intimate visual image of another and sentenced him to restriction for 20 days.

Navy Region Hawaii

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, EMN3 Aaron M. Lindsey, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to attempted sexual abuse of a child. On 1 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 6 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Navy Region Japan

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, DC3 Emerson A. Ovando, USN, was tried for two specifications of sexual assault and one specification of abusive sexual contact. On 24 June 2022, the panel of members returned a verdict of guilty for two specifications of sexual assault and one specification of abusive sexual contact. The panel of members sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 3 years and 6 months, and a Dishonorable Discharge.
- At a General Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, PS2 Aries G. Costelo, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of larceny of military property of a value of more than \$1000, two specifications of fraudulent use during any 1 year period of an access device to obtain property the aggregate value of which is more than \$1000, and one specification of fraud against the United States. On 30 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1, confinement for 12 months, and a fine of \$10,000. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, MR2 Shea M. Mertens, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to four specifications of wrongful use of a controlled

substance. On 13 June 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-1 and confinement for 6 months. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
