

The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in November 2020. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried.

Naval District Washington

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Washington, DC, a MIDN was tried for sexual assault. On 6 November 2020, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a General Court-Martial in Washington, DC, STSC Justin G. Denny, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to wrongful use of a controlled substance, wrongful sale of a firearm to a person he believed to be an unlawful user of controlled substances, and drunken operation of a vehicle. On 12 November 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-3, confinement for 2 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a General Court-Martial in Washington, DC, MIDN Matthew A. Mosley, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to wrongful possession of child pornography, obstruction of justice, and unlawful absence. On 13 November 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to confinement for 20 months and a Dismissal.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Washington, DC, CTRCS Randy W. Tompkins, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to two specifications of assault consummated by a battery. On 9 November 2020, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-7 and confinement for 30 days. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement all confinement will be disapproved.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Washington, DC, LT Caulin D. Collier, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to abuse of a training leadership position. On 23 November 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to a letter of reprimand and to forfeit \$250 pay per month for 9 months. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's board of inquiry.

Navy Region Mid-Atlantic

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Great Lakes, Illinois, MA1 Troy W. Sigler, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to unauthorized absence terminated by apprehension, violation of a lawful general order to notify his command of his civilian

arrest, assault consummated by a battery on an intimate partner, strangling an intimate partner, and two specifications of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer by violating a Military Protective Order. On 2 November 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-3 and confinement for 14 months.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Great Lakes, Illinois, GSM1 Michael A. Prall, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to making a recording of the private area of a person without that person's consent. On 3 November 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-2, confinement for 45 days, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia ABH3 Teon E. Jenkins, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to indecent conduct. On 17 November 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 150 days, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, an E-6, USN, was tried for wrongful introduction of a controlled substance. On 24 November 2020, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty.

Navy Region Southeast

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, AT3 Justin M. Gortzig, USN, was tried for two specifications of sexual assault of a child and two specifications of sexual abuse of a child. On 6 November 2020, the panel of members found him guilty of four specifications of sexual abuse of a child and sentenced him to forfeit \$866 pay per month for 3 months, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, an E-3, USN, was tried for two specifications of sexual assault. On 13 November 2020, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a General Court-Martial in Pensacola, Florida, an E-3, USN, was tried for sexual assault. On 13 November 2020, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, an E-3, USN, was tried for two specifications of sexual assault of a child. On 19 November 2020, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.

- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, an E-8, USN, was tried for sexual assault of a child and sexual abuse of a child. On 23 November 2020, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.

Special Court-Martial

Navy Region Northwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, AM3 Suphachat Suwannee, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to making a recording of the private area of a person without that person's consent and housebreaking. On 18 November 2020, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 1 year, and a Bad Conduct Discharge. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, the punitive discharge will be suspended. The punitive discharge may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, HMC Rodney D. Harvey, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to sexual harassment and two specifications of assault consummated by a battery. On 19 November 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to a reprimand and reduction in rank to paygrade E-6. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, YN2 Jared D. Wilson, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to assault consummated by a battery. On 23 November 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-3 and confinement for 35 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Navy Region Southwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, YNSN Colby J. Petraitis, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to housebreaking, assault consummated by a battery, two specifications of abusive sexual contact, unauthorized absence, and assault consummated by a battery upon an intimate partner. On 9 November 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 36 months, and a Dishonorable Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, AR Maserlin D. Ellison, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to resisting arrest, assault consummated by a battery, and two specifications of assault upon a petty officer. On 17 November 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to confinement for 6 months. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
