

**The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in November 2022. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried.**

## **Naval District Washington**

### **General Court-Martial**

- None.

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, VA, HT1 Joshua Mirrotto, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of assault consummated by a battery upon a petty officer. On 9 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 10 days confinement.

## **Navy Region Mid-Atlantic**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, LT James Rubin, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of absence without leave and three specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 18 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 12 months confinement. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's board of inquiry.
- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, PR1 Christopher Heinen, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 21 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 90 days confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction in paygrade to E-1, and forfeitures of pay and allowances for 3 months.

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, ABFAN Rayshon Tention, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of failing to go to appointed place of duty, two specifications of soliciting the commission of an offense, one specification of communicating a threat, and one specification of domestic violence. On 4 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 7 months confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Great Lakes, Illinois, SA Samuel Quan, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of failing to obey other lawful written order, one specification of violating a general order, and one specification of wrongful

use and possession of an unauthorized military pass with the intent to defraud or deceive. On 9 November 2022, the military judge sentenced him to 90 days confinement, reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a fine of \$10,000. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, SN Solomon Stovall-Ceja, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 15 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 45 days confinement and reduction in paygrade to E-1. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, AWSR Gabriel Zapata, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of desertion, two specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance, and one specification of wrongful distribution of a controlled substance. On 16 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 54 days confinement and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

## **Navy Region Southeast**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, OSSR Derek Henry, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of attempted receipt of child pornography, one specification of receipt of child pornography, and one specification of indecent conduct. On 29 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 59 months confinement and a Dishonorable Discharge.

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, EMN2 Nathan Overby, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of assault consummated by a battery upon a child under 16 years. On 9 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 30 days confinement and reduction in paygrade to E-3. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

## **Navy Region Southwest**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, CSSR Joshua Brice, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of failing to obey other lawful written order, one specification of aggravated assault by strangulation upon a spouse, and two specifications of assault consummated by a battery upon a spouse. On 2 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 8 months confinement and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, FC3 Joshua Zimmerman, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of viewing child pornography. On 3 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 24 months confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.
- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, SB2 David Parent, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of viewing child pornography. On 14 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 7 months confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.
- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, BM3 Kerry Moore, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to five specifications of wrongful broadcast of intimate visual images and three specifications of wrongful appropriation of a value of \$1,000 or less. On 23 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 8 months confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, EMN1 Keven McNulty, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of failing to obey other lawful order and one specification of abuse of position as a military recruiter. On 2 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 5 months confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-3.
- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, EO3 Brandon Reyes-Salvatierra, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of obstructing justice. On 29 November 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 10 days confinement and reduction in paygrade to E-3. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
