

The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in October 2022. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried.

Naval District Washington

General Court-Martial

- None.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Washington, DC, CDR Edward Hill, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 18 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to no punishment. The plea agreement contained a requirement to submit a retirement request.

Navy Region Mid-Atlantic

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Great Lakes, Illinois, ETSN Juan Rosa, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to eight specifications of indecent recording and two specifications of attempting to make an indecent recording. On 5 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 18 months confinement, a Dishonorable Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.
- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, GM1 Jeffrey Erwin, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of communicating a threat and one specification of assault consummated by a battery on a child. On 25 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 45 days confinement and reduction in paygrade to E-3. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, STG2 Dean Young, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of sexual abuse of a child involving indecent communication. On 6 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 35 days confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, PSSN Akuetegeorges Adamah, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of assault consummated by a

battery. On 12 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 100 days confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction in paygrade to E-3, and forfeiture of two-thirds pay for 2 months. The military judge recommended to suspend the Bad Conduct Discharge and, pursuant to the plea agreement, the discharge was suspended. The suspended discharge may be implemented if the Service Member violates the terms of the plea agreement.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, LT Margaret Gresham, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 28 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced her to no punishment. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's board of inquiry.

Navy Region Southeast

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, EMNC Shane Burton, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of sexual abuse of a child involving sexual contact. On 6 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 12 months confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-6.
- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, ITS1 Chad Kaczowski, USN, was tried for violations of one specification of attempted sexual assault of a child and two specifications of attempted sexual abuse of a child involving indecent communication. On 27 October 2022, a panel of members returned a verdict of guilty to all specifications. The military judge sentenced him to 8 years confinement, a Dishonorable Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, LSC Sampson Gargano, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of wrongful appropriation of a value or more than \$1,000, two specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance, one specification of absence without leave, and one specification of assault upon persons in the execution of law enforcement duties. On 4 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 365 days confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Pensacola, Florida, AN Collyn Nelson, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of violating a lawful written order and one specification of absence without leave. On 6 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 30 days confinement, reduction in paygrade to E-1, and forfeiture of one-half month's pay for 2 months. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, YN2 Bryson Williams, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of obstructing justice and one specification of violating a general regulation. On 11 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 60 days confinement and reduction in paygrade to E-3. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, an E-6, USN, was tried for violations of two specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 13 October 2022, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty to both specifications.

Navy Region Southwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, an E-4, USN, was tried for violations of two specifications of assault consummated by a battery upon a spouse. On 14 October 2022, a panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty to both specifications.
- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, IT2 Brandon Zachary, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of communicating indecent language and one specification of viewing child pornography. On 25 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 12 months confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, HM3 Andrew Frederickson, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of failure to obey other lawful order. On 4 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 62 days confinement. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, CSSN Doron White, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of possession of a controlled substance with the intent to distribute. On 20 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 3 months confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.

Navy Region Hawaii

General Court-Martial

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, TMC Jonathan Holmes, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of drunk and disorderly conduct. On 4 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-5. Pursuant to the plea agreement, any reduction in paygrade is to be suspended. The suspended punishment may be implemented if the Service Member violates the terms of the plea agreement.

Navy Region Japan

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, CSSSN Christopher Marshall, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to four specifications of failure to obey other lawful order, four specifications of dereliction of duty, and five specifications of obstructing justice. On 11 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 36 months confinement, a Dishonorable Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.

General Court-Martial

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Naples, Italy, LT Sean Pine, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of drunken operation of a vehicle resulting in personal injury, one specification of leaving the scene of a vehicle accident, and one specification of false official statement. On 17 October 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to no punishment. Pursuant to the plea agreement, the Service Member is required to pay restitution to the victims of the stated offenses.
