

**The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in September 2020. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried.**

## **Naval District Washington**

### **General Court-Martial**

- None

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Great Lakes, Illinois, AA Ravon D. S. Washington, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to six specifications of stealing mail. On 1 September 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 30 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

## **Navy Region Mid-Atlantic**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, an E-6, USN, was tried for sexual assault. On 4 September 2020, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.
- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, YN3 William E. Beard, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to conspiracy to commit wrongful distribution of a controlled substance, wrongful distribution of a controlled substance, wrongful use of a controlled substance, and false official statement. On 10 September 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 18 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, HN Jacob O. Raulino, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to unauthorized absence for more than 30 days. On 17 September 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 35 days, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, AE3 Ruben Lopez, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to wrongful distribution of a controlled substance, wrongful possession of a controlled substance, and conspiracy to commit wrongful distribution of a controlled substance. On 24 September 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 8 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

## **Navy Region Southeast**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, Florida, CMCS Luis H. Garcia, USN, was tried for unauthorized absence, disrespect towards a superior commissioned officer, willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer, violation of a military protective order, and two specifications of sexual assault. On 8 September 2020, the panel of members found him guilty of unauthorized absence and sentenced him to a reprimand and to forfeit \$2,000 pay per month for one month.

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, EN2 Bryant K. Miller, USN, was tried for three specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 9 September 2020, the military judge returned a verdict of guilty for three specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance and sentenced him to no additional punishment.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, MM2 Kristen D. Albright, USN, was tried for wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 18 September 2020, the military judge returned a verdict of guilty for wrongful use of a controlled substance and sentenced her to a reprimand and reduction in rank to paygrade E-4.

## **Navy Region Northwest**

### **General Court-Martial**

- None

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, OS2 Nainoa K. Villegas, USN, was tried for damaging non-military property, burglary, unlawful entry, and two specifications of assault consummated by a battery. On 17 September 2020, the panel of members found him guilty of burglary, unlawful entry, and two specifications of assault consummated by a battery and sentenced him to forfeit \$1,534 pay per month for two months, reduction in rank to paygrade E-3, and confinement for 60 days.

## **Navy Region Southwest**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, AM2 Jasan E. Williams, USN, was tried for four specifications of sexual assault. On 21 September 2020, the panel of members found him guilty of two specifications of sexual assault and sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 18 months, and a Dishonorable Discharge.
- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, CS2 Devon A. Williams, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to three specifications of rape of a child, one specification of sexual abuse of a child, three specifications of attempted sexual abuse of a child, and one specification of viewing child pornography. On 21 September 2020, the military judge sentenced him to be discharged with a Dishonorable Discharge, reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, and confinement for 33 years. Pursuant to the pretrial agreement, all confinement in excess of 16 years will be suspended. The suspended confinement may be served if the Service Member violates the terms of the pretrial agreement.

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, GSM3 Pablo A. Bonillacolon, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to violation of a lawful general order by traveling to Mexico without permission. On 23 September 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 75 days, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, ABFAA Keyshawn J. Ray, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to wrongful possession of a controlled substance and wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 24 September 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 35 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, CS2 Moncure I. Dillingham, USN, was tried for drunken operation of a vehicle. On 30 September 2020, the military judge returned a verdict of guilty for drunken operation of a vehicle and sentenced him reduction in rank to paygrade E-4 and confinement for 30 days.

## **Navy Region Hawaii**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, CTN3 Joshua D. Yates, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to violation of a military protective order, damaging non-military property, four specifications of assault consummated by a battery on an intimate partner, and obstruction of justice. On 1 September 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, forfeit all pay and allowances, confinement for 10 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

## **Navy Region Japan**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, AN Trajon Jeter, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to aggravated assault, assault consummated by a battery, simple assault, and destruction of military property. On 8 September 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 25 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

## **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, ABHAN Sheldon Myers, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to aggravated assault and drunk and disorderly conduct. On 1 September 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 90 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, HN Desmond Bouldin, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to four specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance, two specifications of wrongful distribution of a controlled substance, and one specification of conspiracy to commit wrongful distribution of a controlled substance. On 4 September 2020, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 90 days. The pretrial agreement had no effect on his sentence. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

## **Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, MA2 Victor Green, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to violating a lawful general order by consuming more than two alcoholic beverages in a twenty-four hour period, violating a lawful general order by driving a vehicle less than eight hours after drinking alcohol, violating a lawful order by leaving base without authorization, conspiracy to leave base without authorization, damaging military property, and operation of a vehicle while drunk. On 9 September 2020, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1, confinement for 15 months, and a Bad Conduct Discharge. The pretrial agreement had no effect on his sentence.

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Naples, Italy, ADAN Jacob S. Sobilo, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a pretrial agreement to four specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance and one specification of violation of a lawful order by leaving base without authorization and consuming alcohol. On 29 September 2020, consistent with the pretrial agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in rank to paygrade E-1 and confinement for 200 days. The pretrial agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
