

The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in September 2022. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried.

Naval District Washington

General Court-Martial

- None.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Washington, DC, BM3 Cheyenne Rogers, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 27 September 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced her to 21 days confinement, forfeitures of pay and allowances for 1 month, and reduction in paygrade to E-2. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Navy Region Mid-Atlantic

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Great Lakes, Illinois, ET3 Logan Waid, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of attempting to receive child pornography and one specification of sexual abuse of a child by communicating indecent language. On 7 September 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 10 months confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.
- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, PS1 Emori Agahi, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of fraudulent use of a checking account. On 14 September 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced her to a fine of \$750 and reduction in paygrade to E-4. The plea agreement contained a requirement to submit a retirement request.
- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, an E-4, USN, was tried for violations of one specification of sexual assault and one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 30 September 2022, the panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty to all charges and specifications.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, LSCS Jason Luedke, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of a violation of a lawful general order.

On 9 September 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-7. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, IC2 Jeffrey Fox, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of larceny of property of a value of \$1,000 or less. On 13 September 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 31 days confinement and reduction in paygrade to E-3. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Navy Region Southeast

General Court-Martial

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Mayport, Florida, an E-9, USN, was tried for violations of two specifications of failing to obey other lawful order and one specification of abusive sexual contact. On 15 September 2022, a panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty to all charges and specifications.

Navy Region Northwest

General Court-Martial

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, CSSC Christopher Kittinger, USN, pled guilty pursuant to plea agreement to one specification of drunk and disorderly conduct. On 1 September 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 60 days confinement, forfeitures of pay and allowances for 3 months, and reduction in paygrade to E-6.

Navy Region Southwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, an E-2, USN, was tried for violations of one specification of willfully hazarding a vessel and one specification of aggravated arson. On 30 September, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty to all charges and specifications.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, YNSN Tyler Jones, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of stalking and two specifications of assault consummated by a battery. On 9 September, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 6 months confinement, a Bad Conduct Discharge, and reduction in paygrade to E-1.
- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, California, LS2 Christina Sweet, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 16 September 2022, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced her to reduction in paygrade to E-4. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, an E-7, USN, was tried for a violation of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 14 September 2022, the military judge returned a verdict of not guilty to the charge and sole specification.
